# The Health Science Career Academy

The Health Science Career Academy is a program that is part of both our Career Technical Education Program and STEM. Students in the Health Science Career Academy will have the opportunity to explore relevant courses in the Health Sciences field. Students receive practical, hands-on instruction

from introduction to healthcare (Health Team Relations) to specific college-level courses at Wake Tech or on-line. The Health Science Career Academy is a great place for students who may be interested in future careers in healthcare including doctors, nurses, pharmacy technicians, EMT Specialists, or any other healthcare related field. Students in the Health Science Career Academy will also have the opportunity to work with professionals through a required internship. Students must register for one of the following courses: Public Safety I, Foundations of Health Science, or Agriscience Applications during the freshman year.
